Utilization of the spiral curriculum model where learning of gradually increasing complexity about health sciences and research is spread vertically over the period of four years.

OPPORTUNITY OF A LIFETIME

Interested 8th candidates should apply through Region One. Two students will be selected from each participating Region One GEAR UP Pathways to the Future campus in January 2023.

WHAT IS LASER?

LASER is an extremely selective, one-of-a-kind, four-year program offered by the DHR Health Institute for Research and Development in partnership with DHR Health and Region One GEAR UP Pathways to the Future for students who are interested in pursuing careers in healthcare, STEM, and/or clinical research. A total of 44 students will be selected for the four year program, which will be held on the DHR Health campus in Edinburg, Texas. Acceptance into the LASER program requires a four-year commitment from students and their parents/guardians.

Students will participate in numerous healthcare activities for the four-year period, all of which will prepare them for their careers by developing self-confidence, critical thinking, and leadership skills.

The LASER program will begin in February 2023 with an Endorsement Exhibition that will showcase ten healthcare careers as 8th grade students prepare to choose their path of study in high school. A one-week summer internship will follow during the first week of June 2023 in which students will be exposed to a variety of topics in healthcare, in addition to immersion tours and practicum exercises. Learning opportunities will continue throughout their high school career.
